*WHAT IS A FLEX PASS?

A **Flex Pass** is basically a discount pack of four admissions to The Playhouse. It's a discount because you pay \$25.50 per ticket [\$23.00 for members] as compared to the single ticket price.

For which shows can a Flex Pass be used? Flex Passes are valid for the SUMMER SERIES of four shows (**June 9 – Oct 2 only**.) Off

Season shows are separate and tickets must be purchased separately.

Do dates have to be chosen when a Flex Pass is purchased? No. But it's always wise to book early to get the date & time preferred. You don't have to wait until a show opens before you book. You can book for all shows as early as you want.

Are there enough seats to accommodate all Flex Pass holders? Yes. We have many more available seats than Flex Pass holders, so there is ample opportunity to use the Flex Pass. But it is the **responsibility of Flex Pass holder** to book EARLY ENOUGH to use their four admissions.
