Summer Theatre School

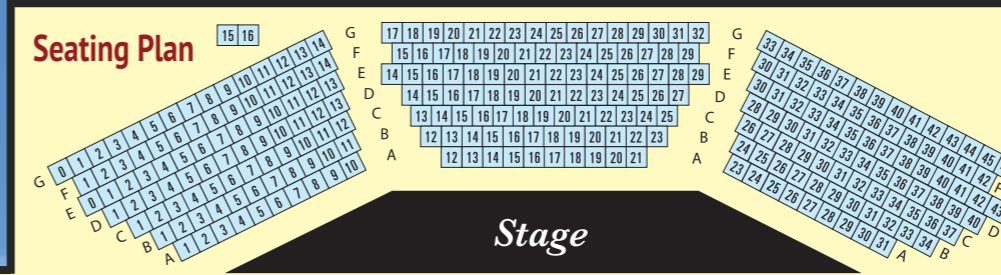
